The agenda will include public comment, discussion and possible action to approve a CSM and conservation easement to be submitted by David Heagle, dead end sign on 143rd Street, set a sale price for plow truck and where and how to advertise, mobile home park license transfer, road for L.R.I.P (local road improvement program), options for payment of the truck, set the date for the fall public budget hearing and special town meeting of the electors, request that a future town road be reserved for alternative access to a potential development, Ditching and Culverts on 226th, work on budget, request from We Energies to bring a natural gas line into the Town of Bloomer, update on the tractor and mower demonstration, update on E.T.Z. (extra territorial zoning), update from the fire and ambulance meeting, Chippewa County Humane Society contract, update from the Wisconsin Towns Association training session, and any correspondence received by the Town.
