

## **May 11, 2020 Regular Board Meeting**

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on May 11, 2020 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:30 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Brian Lueck, Brian Frion, Roxanne Geurkink, and Ashley Nelson

Guests Present: Gary Zwiefelhofer

Public Comment: None

All board members were provided with a copy of the April 14, 2020 Town Board Meeting minutes. Supervisor Frion made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor Lueck second the motion. Motion carried.

Receipts 7316 and 7329 were presented.

Checks 10156-10177 and 2 electronic transfers were presented. Supervisor Frion made a motion to pay the bills and approve the financial report. Supervisor Lueck second the motion. Motion carried.

Results of the road inspection are that the roads basically remain with the same road ratings. However, a couple of the road ratings were lowered. The Town will obtain 23 loads of patch and rent the roller from the City of Bloomer and the Grader from A-1 and complete the work ourselves.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to overlay on 85<sup>th</sup> approximately 1 mile and overlay on 210<sup>th</sup> from Highway F to a little over ½ mile. The overlay will be approximately 2 1/2". Supervisor Lueck second the motion. Motion carried.

Chairman Nehring made a motion for the following culverts.

- The culvert on 230<sup>th</sup> will be left as is.
- The culvert on 237<sup>th</sup> will be replaced.
- The culvert on 242<sup>nd</sup> has the DNR approval and can be replaced as planned. The bridge aid papers have been signed and submitted previously but work had not been completed yet.

Supervisor Lueck second the motion. Motion carried.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to increase the road worker's wages for Gary Zwiefelhofer and Matthew Hartman from \$16.00 per hour to \$17.00 per hour beginning June 1, 2020 to be paid in July 2020. Supervisor Lueck second the motion. This item has also been discussed and approved at the Town's Annual meeting.

After much research and inquiries, the new Town truck is closer to being ordered.

Various correspondence and mail items were discussed.

The next Town Board Meeting will be Monday, June 8, 2020 at 7:00 pm.
