

August 13, 2018 Regular Board Meeting

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on August 13, 2018 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:30 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Roger McFarlane, Brian Lueck, Roxanne Geurkink, and Ashley Nelson

The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance.

All board members were furnished with a copy of the minutes from the July 9, 2018 Town Board meeting and the July 23, 2018 Special Town Board meeting. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried.

Receipts 7033 - 7044 were presented.

Checks 10125 – 10146 and 2 electronic transfers were presented. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to pay the bills and approve the financial report. Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried.

Supervisor McFarlane made a motion to adopt the Town Transportation Resolution. Supervisor Lueck second. Motion carried. The Town Transportation Resolution is attached and made a part of these minutes.

A few Townships, which do not have local zoning and follow Chippewa County zoning, are asking Townships within Chippewa County to support a moratorium on CAFO (Confined Animal Feeding Operations). The Bloomer Town board is recommending that the Town of Bloomer Planning Commission examine this item as it may not be addressed in the Town's Zoning Ordinance.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to approve the operator's license application from Samantha Fischer. Supervisor Lueck second. Motion carried.

Updates were given from the recent County Unit Meeting and the recent Election Training and Emergency Response workshop.

Various correspondence and mail items were discussed.
