

April 10, 2017 Regular Board Meeting

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on April 10, 2017 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:30 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Roger McFarlane, Brian Lueck, Roxanne Geurkink, and Patricia Clark

The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance.

All board members were furnished with the minutes of the March 13, 2017 Town Board meeting. Supervisor McFarlane made a motion to approve the minutes, Supervisor Lueck second. Motion carried.

Receipts 6824 – 6838 were presented.

Checks 9706 – 9731 and 2 electronic transfers were presented. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to pay the bills and accept the financial report, Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to appoint Brian Lueck, Brian Frion, and Andrew Mashak for a 3 year term to the Planning Commission. Supervisor McFarlane second the motion. Motion carried.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to appoint Tom Ewings, Cory Bixby, ~~Gary Nehring~~, and Tom Ruff for a 3 year term to the Board of Appeals, Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried.
and Gary Nehring for a 2 year term.

Chairman Nehring was advised by the board to contact Waste Management with a few questions/clarifications regarding their service contract. If the Town wants to not renew the contract with Waste Management, the request will need to be made within the next month or so.

Based on the inventory of culverts the Town has on hand, the Town will purchase 10 15" culverts.

The Town will purchase a security light for the Town Hall. The current security light was damaged by the recent high winds.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to approve the operator's license application from Jennifer Nyhus (Back Forty Dining), Supervisor Lueck second. Motion carried.

The ETZ (extra territorial zoning) will be holding a meeting. The board discussed specific questions and clarifications that they want brought up for discussion at this next ETZ meeting.

Reports were given from the fire and ambulance meeting and the county highway training and the district meeting.



Various correspondence and mail items were discussed.
