

## **March 13, 2017 Regular Board Meeting**

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on March 13, 2017 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:30 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Roger McFarlane, Brian Lueck, Roxanne Geurkink, and Patricia Clark

Also present: Tom Clark, Bill LaGesse, Henry Borntreger, and Brian Frion

The meeting began with the pledge of allegiance.

Public Comment: None

All board members were furnished with the minutes of the February 13, 2017 Town Board meeting. Supervisor McFarlane made a motion to approve the minutes as amended, Supervisor Lueck second. Motion carried.

Receipts 6814 – 6823 were presented.

Checks 9676 – 9705 and 2 electronic transfers were presented. Supervisor Lueck made a motion to pay the bills and accept the financial report, Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to approve the application for a liquor license from Danny Brott for Cedar Bay Resort, Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried. The application has been made due to the fact that Cedar Bay Resort has been sold and Danny Brott is the new owner.

The Town has been notified from We Energies that We Energies is not prepared at this time to request and present a resolution for a natural gas line to be installed within the Town.

Chairman Nehring presented the results of the bridge report conducted by the County.

**85<sup>th</sup> street bridge** – pour concrete in front of the south abutment to prevent loss of backfill material

**190<sup>th</sup> avenue bridge** – repair abutment caps

**83rd street bridge** – west end could use heavy rip rap and scour hole developing

The board will schedule a meeting with the County to discuss the recommended repairs

Supervisor Lueck made a motion for the Town to participate in the 2017 Road Ditch Cleanup program being held this spring, Supervisor McFarlane second. Motion carried.

The date of the annual road inspection of the Town roads will be April 20, 2017 meeting at the Bloomer Town hall at 8:30 am.

The Town has two parcels that have delinquent personal property taxes owned by two different individuals/businesses. The only way the Town can collect these past due taxes if the owner will not pay, would be to take the owner to small claims court. The Board instructed the Town Treasurer to send a letter to the delinquent personal property owners stating that the taxes are past due and need to be paid.

The Town's annual meeting will be held Tuesday, April 18, 2017 at 7:30 pm at the Bloomer Town hall.

Various correspondence items and mail were discussed. Information from the Fire and Ambulance indicates that the new ambulance will cost approximately \$176,882.00 with the Town's share being 17% or approximately \$30,000.00.

The next Town Board Meeting will be Monday, April 10, 2017 at 7:30 pm.
