

June 8, 2022 Regular Board Meeting

The Town of Bloomer regular monthly meeting was held on June 8, 2022 at the Bloomer Town Hall and was called to order by Chairman Gary Nehring at 7:00 pm.

Board Members present were: Gary Nehring, Brian Frion, Brian Lueck, Roxanne Geurkink and Ashley Nelson

Guests Present: Roger McFarlane

Public Comment: None.

All board members were provided a copy of the minutes from the May 9, 2022 Town Board meeting that was postponed and reconvened on May 11, 2022. Chairman Nehring made a motion to approve the minutes. Supervisor Lueck second the motion. Motion carried.

Receipts 7608 - 7612 were presented.

Checks 10749-10769 and 2 electronic transfers were presented. Chairman Nehring made a motion to approve the report and pay the bills. Supervisor Lueck second the motion. Motion carried.

The preliminary estimates for the road work for the BIL-STP Program were received from Cedar Corporation. This program is an 80/20 road funding program. The estimates are as follows:

210th - the Town's share is \$143,831.00 which is 20% of the project's cost

90th - the Town's share is \$136,587.00 which is 20% of the project's cost

No action needs to be taken on this item as the Town will be informed from the state if either of these projects are approved.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to hire Roger McFarlane as an interim zoning administrator at \$20.00 per hour plus mileage and expenses. Supervisor Luck second the motion. Motion carried.

Various options and features and models of boom mowers were discussed. This item is tabled for now.

Chairman Nehring made a motion to nominate Paul Bembnister to the Board of Appeals for a 3 year term. Supervisor Frion second the motion. Motion carried.

Various correspondence and mail items were discussed.
